Assam down town University signed an Agreement for collaboration for academic cooperation between the two institutions on 13th November, 2018 in an auspicious function held at the Board Room, Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati. The agreement was signed by Dr. N.N. Dutta (Chancellor) for Assam down town University and Prof. Gautam Biswas (Director) for Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati. The tenure of the agreement will be for five years. The two Institutes/ Universities agreed to enhance the collaborative agreement through a) to exchange information on research and educational programs, b) to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs, c) to jointly propose/organize short-term continuing education programs, trainings on topics of mutual interest and to invite researchers of both the institutions to participate therein, and d) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, researchers and students for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.

Dr. B G Unni (Director Research) gave away brief appraisal about the overview of research activities undertaken by the University, future program and also spoke about the scope of academic collaboration with IIT Guwahati with Assam down town University for the long days to come. Director, Dean Research & Development, Dean & Associate Dean Alumni Affairs & External relations, Head of Department Bioscience & Bioengineering and other officials were attended the function from IIT Guwahati. The MoU signing function ended with a vote of thanks by Dr.Ajaikumar B Kunnumakkara Associate Professor of Bioscience & Bioengineering to all the members for their participation at the meeting.
