**MINUTES OF IQAC MEETING**

ITEMS:	DISCUSSIONS & RESOLUTIONS:
NIRF data presented by IQAC	Deputy Director of IQAC presented AdtU's NIRF data to all the members present at the meeting. The ranking declaration by NIRF, ranking Methodology, the five parameters and the sub points of the parameters were presented and discussed. Honorable Vice Chancellor commented on the instability of the Programmes intake provided in the various Faculties.
Placement	Deputy Director of IQAC presented data comparison of AdtU and other prominent universities of Assam to show the placement differences. After the comparative analysis of the data, Honorable Vice Chancellor suggested to keep track of the students and alumni's regarding their placements. He also suggested that an expert to be placed in the Placement Cell to develop a

	specific method and approach to streamline the placement of the alumni.
Ph.D	<p>PhD details of AdtU were presented by Deputy Director of IQAC.</p> <p>The members of the meeting raised their concern regarding clarification of Full time PhD students and Part time PhD students.</p> <p>On this matter Honorable Vice Chancellor suggested a change in the policy to redefine the definition of Full time and Part time PhD students.</p>
Online Courses	<p>The data showing online courses provided in AdtU was presented by Deputy Director, IQAC.</p> <p>After the analysis, it was found that there is a need for more online courses. It was also clarified that Coursera is not considered as an online course.</p> <p>Dr. Prateeti Barman further added that Coursera is a credit based course.</p>
IPR	<p>Data of patented and published research projects was presented by Deputy Director, IQAC.</p> <p>Hon. Vice Chancellor suggested that there is need to increase the number of patents and published projects to achieve better results in the NIRF ranking.</p>
Sponsored Research	<p>The data of sponsored research was presented by Deputy Director, IQAC.</p> <p>As per the data the numbers of sponsors were less in number in comparison to the data of other prominent universities. However the funding received was found to be more or the less the same.</p>
Admissions	<p>With regards to the data of Admissions, Hon. Vice Chancellor observed inconsistencies in the intake of different Programmes of UG and PG. He further suggested everyone in attendance to devise a strategy for streamlining the admissions process for the various UG and PG programmes.</p>
NIRF results (Parameter wise)	<p>The parameter wise results of NIRF ranking 2022 of AdtU, Faculty of Commerce and Management and Faculty of Science were discussed thoroughly.</p> <p>As per the collective observation of the results of the five parameters it was found that the Outreach and Inclusivity Perception of AdtU has decreased in comparison to the previous year's NIRF result.</p>
