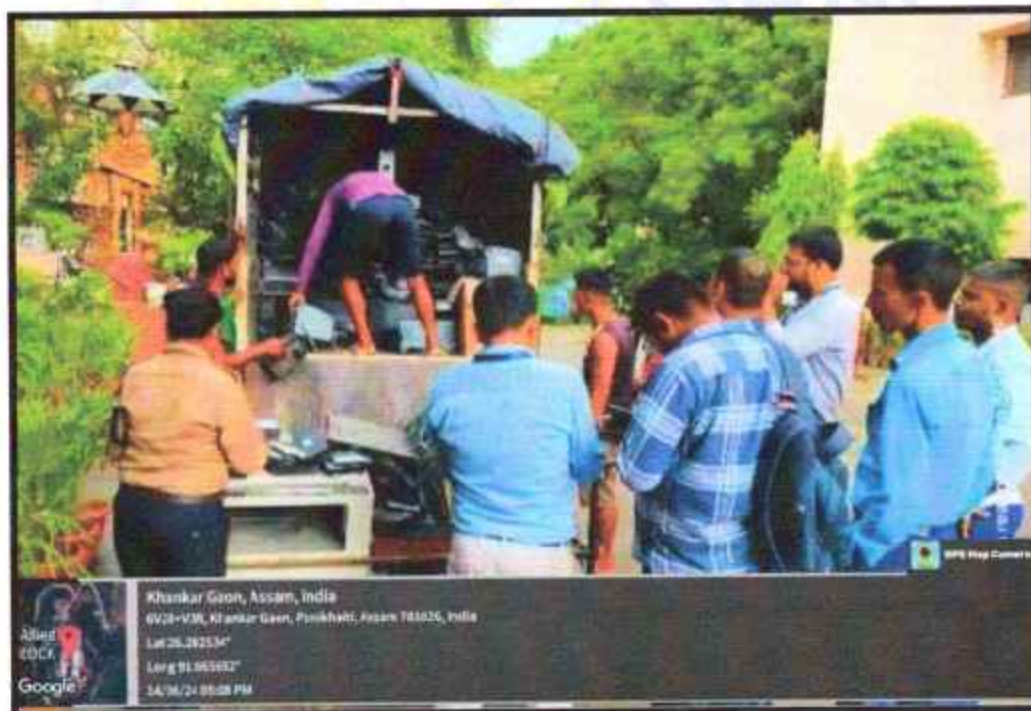


Fig: - 4(c) Disposal of E-Waste inside AdtU Campus

Background:

WHEREAS, both Parties recognize the importance of responsible e-waste management to mitigate the environmental impact of electronic devices.

WHEREAS, both Parties desire to collaborate to ensure the effective disbursement of e-waste from the Seller to the Purchaser for proper recycling and disposal.

Objectives:

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration between the Seller and the Purchaser to achieve the following objectives:

1. To promote responsible e-waste management and raise awareness about the importance of recycling electronic devices.
2. To establish a system for the disbursement of e-waste from the Seller to the Purchaser for proper recycling and disposal.
3. To ensure compliance with local, national, and international regulations regarding e-waste management.
4. To track and document the progress and outcomes of the e-waste disbursement program.
5. To explore opportunities for joint research and development initiatives related to e-waste management.

Terms and Conditions:

1. E-Waste Disbursement:

- a. The Seller agrees to provide the Purchaser with e-waste collected from its facilities or authorized drop-off points.
- b. The e-waste disbursement will be carried out according to an agreed-upon schedule and in a manner that ensures the safe transport and handling of the materials.

2. Responsibilities of the Seller:

- a. The Seller will properly segregate and package the e-waste in accordance with applicable regulations and industry best practices.
- b. The Seller will provide an inventory list of the disbursed e-waste to the Purchaser, including details such as quantity, types of devices, and condition.

3. Responsibilities of the Purchaser:

- a. The Purchaser will receive, process, and dispose of the e-waste in an environmentally sound and responsible manner, adhering to applicable laws and regulations.
- b. The Purchaser will provide documentation of the e-waste handling process, including recycling, refurbishment, or disposal activities, to the Seller.
- c. The Purchaser will ensure that any sensitive data stored in the electronic devices is securely erased or destroyed.

4. Reporting and Monitoring:

- a. Both Parties will establish a reporting mechanism to track the disbursement, processing, and disposal of e-waste.
- b. The Purchaser will provide periodic reports to the Seller regarding the progress, outcomes, and environmental impact of the e-waste disbursement program.

5. Duration and Termination:

- a. This MoU will remain in effect for a period of 3 years, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement or due to unforeseen circumstances.
- b. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing a written notice to the other party with a reasonable notice period.

6. Confidentiality:

- a. Both Parties agree to treat any confidential information shared during the course of this collaboration with utmost confidentiality and not to disclose it to any third party without prior written consent.

7. Governing Law:

This MoU will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Assam, India. Any disputes arising from this MoU will be settled amicably through mutual negotiations. In case of failure to reach a resolution, the Parties agree to submit the dispute to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Guwahati, Assam.

8. Force Majeure:

Neither party shall be held liable for any delay or failure in performing its obligations under this MoU due to events beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, war, terrorism, riots, or governmental actions ("Force Majeure Event"). In the event of a Force Majeure Event, the affected party shall notify the other party in writing, providing reasonable details of the event and its impact on the performance of this MoU. The obligations of the Parties shall be suspended during the Force Majeure Event, and they shall make reasonable efforts to mitigate the effects of such an event.

9. Entire Agreement:

This MoU constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter herein and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, negotiations, and discussions, whether written or oral, relating to the same. No modification or amendment to this MoU shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and signed by both Parties.

This MoU may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

11. Severability:

If any provision of this MoU is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired.

12. Assignment:

Neither party shall assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this MoU without the prior written consent of the other party.
